NORTH INDIA FLOODS - DISASTER APPEAL

Hindu Swayamsevak Sangh UK is supporting Sewa UK - North India Floods Disaster Appeal.

The rains came in Uttarakhand in northern India on Friday 14th June and by Sunday it was official that Uttarakhand was in the grips of the worst flood in hundred years.

The flooding has washed away at least 1307 roads and nearly 147 bridges. 1751 houses have been damaged and the figure is still rising.

The government of Uttarakhand has announced the official death toll at 550. Rakesh Sharma, a state official said the total number of deaths could soar to several thousands, although the exact figure would not be known until the entire region has been checked.
